SUBJECT: Utilization of the Army's e-Learning Program

1. Purpose. This letter extends the expiration date of HQDA Letter 350-04-1 from 8 January 2007 to 8 January 2009.

2. Proponent and exception authority. The proponent of this HQDA Letter is the Chief Information Officer (CIO/G-6). The CIO/G-6 has the authority to approve exceptions to this HQDA Letter that are consistent with controlling law and regulation. The CIO/G-6 may delegate this authority, in writing, to a division chief within the proponent agency or its direct reporting unit or field operating agency, in the grade of colonel or civilian equivalent. Activities may request a waiver to this regulation by providing justification that includes a full analysis of the expected benefits and must include formal review by the activity's senior legal officer. All waiver requests will be endorsed by the commander or senior leader of the requesting activity and forwarded through their higher headquarters to the policy proponent. Refer to AR 25-30 for specific guidance.
